STBA Terms & Conditions for Supporting Organisations

This document sets out the Terms & Conditions for the purpose of facilitating collaboration between the STBA and its Supporting Organisations. It aims to encourage organisations with an interest in the repair, maintenance, improvement and sustainable refurbishment of traditional buildings to collaborate with and support the STBA.

Context

1. Organisations supporting the STBA will be called Supporting Organisations. Currently only non-profit and public sector organisations can be Supporting Organisations.
2. Participation as a Supporting Organisation will run continually until further notice.
3. The Agreement is non-exclusive in nature; it does not preclude either party entering into any form of agreement with other institutions.
4. There is no financial commitment for Supporting Organisations to engage with the STBA
5. Supporting Organisations will not have any ownership or voting rights in the STBA, which will be managed by the SDF taking advice from the STBA Board.
6. Supporting Organisations will not have any liabilities associated with their involvement in the STBA; the SDF will manage the STBA and any associated liabilities.
7. Supporting Organisations will be under no obligation to contribute to, endorse, or otherwise engage in any specific activity or output from the STBA unless they so choose.

Roles and responsibilities

1. STBA Supporting Organisations will cooperate in the development, implementation and promotion of the STBA as an alliance of built environment organisations, which seeks to promote better understanding of traditional buildings both as existing and when refurbished, and their impact on occupants, environment and society.
2. Supporting Organisations agree to share details of research, events, policy papers and other relevant activities being carried out in this arena and to invite the STBA team to participate where appropriate
3. Where appropriate, the STBA and Supporting Organisations agree to promote each others' work, activities and outputs, for example through their newsletters and websites.
4. The STBA will keep Supporting Organisations informed about progress through the provision of at least 4 newsletters per year
